The season opens with "Juiced up June" on Sunday, June 6 at Ravenswood Manor Park with **Fulton County Line** at 7 pm. This is a very popular country act in town,

Sunday, August 1 at 7 pm features the **Finley McKnight Band**. Opening for them will be a unique group: **The Gaudete Brass Quintet!** Two weeks later on Sunday, August 15 at 7 pm we'll enjoy the sounds of the **Lawrence Peters Outfit** for two solid sets.

Our season closes on Sunday, August 29 at 7 pm with our old friend **Rokko Jans and Friends**, a neighborhood tradition for many years.



Manor Garden Club to Host Annual Plant Sale

The Manor Garden Club is holding its annual Plant Sale Fundraiser on Saturday, May 15 from 10 am to noon. This year the sale will be at Luther Memorial Church, 2500 W. Wilson (at Wilson and Campbell). The sale will be set up on the front lawn - rain or shine.

Luther Memorial Church members will be selling delicious homemade treats and beverages. The sale features a large selection of herbs, vegetables, annuals, and some spring perennials. The plant sale will feature plant varieties that have done well in gardens and containers, as well as some new varieties and heirloom vegetables. Club members will be on hand to answer your questions and assist you with plant choices. Please come early for the best selection.

Your plant purchases help to host presentations at the Garden Club meetings, which cover a wide variety of topics from wildflowers and birds to garden art and design. Meetings are held at Luther Memorial Church on the third Monday of most months at 7:30 pm. All are invited to attend.


